before they journey on.

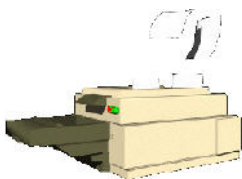
May it be a house of meeting

and answers to their prayer.

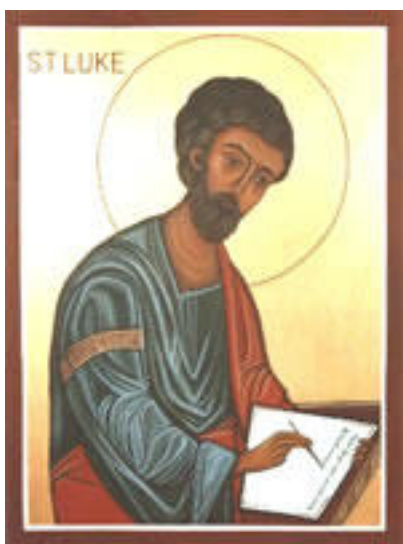
Some call us a house of safety
